IGCSE REGISTRATION FOR 2019/2020 ACADEMIC SESSION

International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) is an internationally recognised certificate that is required by Colleges and Universities in the UK, Malaysia, Canada, Singapore, Hong Kong, and some North American Countries. This examination is usually taken in February/March, May/June and October/November yearly. But as an associate centre, the College Management has chosen the October/November Series.

ST. Gregory's College – As an Associate Centre

The College is a Cambridge Associate Centre, which simply means that her students can register and take the IGCSE in the College. The first set of students are presently taking their IGCSE in the College. This is very important and advantageous in that it takes out the fatigue and stress caused by the often unfavourable traffic situation in Lagos and builds the students' confidence as well as boost their chances of passing with flying colours.

➢ IGCSE LESSON

Day students who are interested are encouraged to plan adequately and attend all IGCSE classes. However, experience gained during previous trainings in the College showed it was stressful for day students. As a result, the College Management would advise that such students change address.

> ONE HIGHER EDUCATION NOTE PER SUBJECT:

It is important that all registered students should have a new higher education note for easy incorporation of all that is taught. We advise that students make available such notes for every subject registered.

Changing of Subjects:

Changing of Subject(s): students are expected to do a wide consultation with the cooperation of their parents before choosing their IGCSE subjects. However, should there be any need for a change of subject, students have from now till December, 2019 to make such changes. There will no opportunity for a change of subject after December, 2019.

Administrative Fee:

Parents are to pay a non-refundable fee of #15,000.00 (Fifteen Thousand Naira Only) as administrative fee after which a token of #10,000.00 (Ten Thousand Naira Only) per subject will be paid termly. A receipt will be issued to this effect. Endeavour to make the receipt available to the coordinator in soft copy for proper documentation.

> Registration Fee:

This is for SS2 Parents. The period for payment given by Cambridge is usually very short, because they expect that making of payments should commence after the prices are made available. The College Management will not want parents to be involved in running helter-skelter in getting their children enrolled for the examination. So parents are expected to pay one-third of the total subject registration

fee released by Cambridge this year, from November, 2019 till April, 2020, and when the actual prices are released by Cambridge, the balance will not be too huge to bear. For instance, we have the following prices from Cambridge for this year's October/November Series:

So if your son is to register for five subjects next year, maybe Maths, English, ICT, Physic, Accounting. The total cost should be 233100, two-third of this amount approximately is 155400:00. So when the actual price is released by June next year, the balance will not be too huge to bear.

> Attendance of Students during the Programme:

This will be taken seriously, as any student who fail to register 100% attendance may not be allowed to take the examination. And if a student is to absent himself from class, the coordinator should be aware, else such student will be dealt with. Parents are to assist in this regard by reiterating the importance of attendance in all their classes.

Getting the right Past Questions:

The past questions can be downloaded from papacambridge.com and some other websites, but one of the serious challenges encountered in previous years is getting the complete year and papers, some students are having some examination papers different from the ones their peers are having, and even omitting some years, in this regard we implore that parents get the right papers. You can contact the coordinator for assistance in this regard. Parents may be asked to reprint these papers, if we discovered that your son is not having the right paper.

> Subject Combination in IGCSE:

The minimum number of subjects a candidate can register for in the Cambridge examinations is five subjects and a maximum of seven (7) or eight (8). A form will be given to students whose parents were present in today's meeting to fill at home, please kindly guide them in filling this form, and possibly browsing the website of institutions abroad to have a clue of the subject required for admission in different departments.
